## Getting Started

1) <http://www.powermediaplus.com> Navigate to PowerMediaPlus.com's home page.

New subscribers [log in here](#).

2) [New subscribers log in here](#). Click the New Subscribers link on the left margin. A new page opens. Already have an account? Skip to Step 8 below.

3) Type in the general passcode in the box provided on the New Subscribers area of the new page.

4) Log in. Click on the Log in button. A new window opens.

5) Fill out your profile and your username and password. \*=required information. Scroll all the way down the page to make sure all required fields are filled in.

6) Write down your username and password as you will need them to log in from this point forward. Your contact person will be able to see your username but you will need to contact PowerMediaPlus to retrieve your password.

7) Save. PowerMediaPlus opens your personalized version of their multimedia website. The first page of this site is called your "Digital Home".

## Browse for Media

You can browse from your Digital Home page or on any page of the site using the "Browse" links on the upper left margin of your screen. Tip: Choosing to "View All" rather than choosing a grade band may lessen the time it takes to locate media.

## By Subject

- 1) Click on "Subjects."
- 2) Select your subject area. *To search more than one subject, use the advanced search.*
- 3) Select which grade level you want to browse.

## By Grade Level

- 1) Click on "Grade levels."
- 2) Select which grade level you want to browse. *To search more than one level, use the advanced search.*
- 3) Select your subject area.

**By State Correlations** The Ohio standard, benchmark, and indicator correlations are based on information provided by state education and testing facilities. Based on the skills required for Ohio and its learning indicators, PowerMediaPlus has suggested programs that fulfill these necessary requirements. You will also find a correlations link on video program detail pages.

- 1) Click on State correlations. *A new page opens.*
- 2) View all Standards. Click the View all standards link. *An extensive list of standards appears.*
- 3) Ohio Academic Achievement Standards. Scroll to and select Ohio's Standards. *A new page opens.*
- 4) Select your subject area. *A new page opens.*
- 5) Select a standard. *A new page opens.*
- 6) Select your grade level. *A new page opens.*
- 7) Select which indicator you want. *A new page opens.*
- 8) Peruse the titles and navigate to any media that might fit your needs.

## Search for Media

You can search from your digital home page or on any page of the site using the search box near the top of the screen. To locate a specific media type, use the pull-down menu and choose: the entire site, video, audio, the image library, print resources, or podcasts.

- 1) By Keyword
  - a) Type your keyword(s) in the box provided. *Examples: lincoln, holidays, civil war, linear equations*
  - b) Go. Choose "Go" or press "Enter."
- 2) Using the Advanced Search (found to the right of the keyword box)
  - a) Type your keyword(s) in the box provided.
  - b) Choose a media type: video, audio, image library, print resources, or podcasts (you can choose more than one). Select how you want your results listed by choosing one of the sort results options.
  - c) Closed-captioned. Check the box if you would like to see only closed-captioned titles.
  - d) Editable titles. Select if you would like to see only editable titles. *Editable titles can be pulled into a user's software such as iMovie, MovieMaker, PowerPoint, iLife to be manipulated and customized.*
  - e) Subjects. Highlight any subjects you would like to search.
  - f) Grade Levels. Select your grade level(s).
  - g) Search.

**Video Test Prep** The video test prep feature helps students prepare for class tests, state exams, and national assessments. By choosing the learning standard, grade level, and the key concept you want to cover, the PowerMediaPlus system will prescribe a customized list of videos and clips. You can quickly generate a playlist from this list, which can be manipulated, viewed, or assigned to students to help them review core concepts before their exams. This section also provides links to digital videos and other resources about test preparation and study skills.

- 1) Digital Home > Video Test Prep. Click the Video Test Prep link at the top, left of the screen. *A new window opens.*
- 2) Select a Standard (SAT, GED, etc.) or click View All Standards and use the drop-down list to choose Ohio Academic Content Standards.
- 3) Test Name. Type in the name of test type for which you are looking. Examples: OGT, Achievement, etc.
- 4) Grade Level. Use the drop-down list to choose a grade level.
- 5) Search for a key concept. (Optional)
- 6) Search. PowerMediaPlus returns a list of media titles.

### **View Media**

While watching video, you can switch to full-screen view by clicking on the full-screen icon to the right of the file playing time. To go back to your media player page from the full-screen view, press the "Esc" key. The full-screen option is only available on PC platforms. *Macintosh users with QuickTime Pro software will be able to play videos full-screen when they open the video in the stand-alone player.*

- 1) Navigate to the selection you wish to hear and/or see. *The selection opens a new window.*
- 2) Play. Click "Play" for the full title **or** for the individual segment of your choice.
- 3) Click "Correlations, Related Items, and Citations" to explore correlations to Ohio Academic Content; to see titles of media related to the topic; and to view MLA, APA, and Chicago Manual of Style bibliographic citations for the selection

### **View the Ohio Correlations PowerMediaPlus Suggests for a Video**

- 1) Scroll down to the bottom of the program detail page. You can also access correlations from the "Correlations, Related Items, and Citations" link.
- 2) Select "State correlations."
- 3) Choose the standards you wish to support from the pull-down menu.

### **Find Print Resources**

#### **Find Print Resources Through the Print Resources Tab**

Link to more than 5,000 print resources, including teacher's guides, worksheets, and learning objectives.

- 1) Click "Print resources", the red tab at the top right of the screen.
- 2) Keyword.
  - a) To search by keyword, type your keyword in the box provided.
  - b) Choose "Go."
- 3) Subject.
  - a) To browse by subject, click on "Subjects" under "Browse" (on the left-hand side of your screen). Choose your subject area (to select more than one, use the advanced search).
  - b) Select your grade level (if a grade level is not listed, there are no resources for that grade level in the subject area).
- 4) Grade Level
  - a) Click on "Grade levels" under "Browse" (on the left-hand side of your screen).
  - b) Choose your grade level (to select more than one, use the advanced search).
  - c) Select your subject area.

**Find Print Resources on the Program Detail Page**

If a particular title has print resources related to it, the resources will be listed toward the bottom of the program detail page (above the “State correlations” and “Related items” links). To view the resource, click on the underlined name of the title.

**Find Print Resources on the Media Player Page**

If a particular title has resources related to it, the resources will be listed underneath the program description to the right of the media player window. To view the resource, click on the underlined name of the title.
